

Registration Terms and Conditions

General

- The GESGB takes bookings on a first come, first served basis.
- All events and other events must be paid for in advance at the time of booking.
- The GESGB reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any booking
- Field trip attendance is restricted to GESGB members only to be covered by our public liability insurance.
- The GESGB will not accept liability for any compensation claim arising from any cancellation of an event, or activity due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Those booking on an event must notify the office at least 14 days prior to the event if they have any special dietary, religious, health or other special requirements.
- The GESGB reserves the right to introduce new charges for new bookings for events and activities prior to an event.
- Photographs may be taken at events for marketing purposes. By attending an event, you are giving us permission to use images in which you may be present. In addition, these images may be shared and stored on third-party platforms. Should you not wish to appear in any images, please notify the photographer at the event and email events@ges-gb.org.uk. Please note we may use your email address to advise you of future events. If you wish to opt out of this, please email events@ges-gb.org.uk
- These booking terms and conditions may be subject to amendment.

Cancellations and Refunds

- The GESGB is unable to refund any cancellations made within 4 weeks of an event or activity taking place. Prior to this a full refund maybe given in the form it was paid at the discretion of the GESGB.
- Cancellations must be made in writing to the society. Any refunds due to member cancellations
 made within refund deadlines will be made at the convenience of the society within 30 days of
 cancellation.
- If an event is cancelled by the GESGB for any reason a full refund will be given (up to the date of cancellation).
- Up to 5 working days prior to any event, members may substitute another member at no extra charge. All substitutions must be advised to the GESGB Office in writing and must include signed confirmation of the place reassignment by the person making the original booking.

Field Trips

- Paid participants are required to make their own travel and catering arrangements.
- Field trip locations and itineraries may be subject to amendments to those publicised due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All field trips have specific Risk Assessments which are available to read on request.
